## Introduction : Pub Bongsor College

Pub Bongsor College, Pacharia was established in 1994 by the conscious and enthusiastic local social workers of seventeen villages under Pub Bongsor Mouza in the district of Kamrup, Assam. The college is situated on the north bank of the mighty Brahmaputra, and is about fifteen kms away from Gauhati University, and also the nearest Gauhati University affiliated college from the district head quarter i.e. Amingaon. Initially, the classes of the college were started at Dadara H.S. School, and the total administration was shifted to its permanent place in the year 1996. Having a good means of transport and communication, the institution of higher education is just three hundred meters away from Guwahati-Singimari-Hajo PWD road and conveniently connected by Pacharia-Singimari PWD Road. The scenic beauty in the midst of agricultural landscape which is free from noise pollution promotes the College for better teaching-learning environment. The College provides the courses in humanities and social sciences.

### Admission Procedure

1. Go to college website and click on “Online Admission” link.
2. Click on “Register Here” to register yourself for Application form fill up.
  - \* Register using name, contact no. and e-mail id.
  - \* One contact no. and one e-mail id. can only be used once.
  - \* Set your own password.
3. After successful registration you can “Login” to applicant’s portal with your contact no. and password.
4. After successful registration, the student can “Download Prospectus” and fill up the admission form.
5. The student portal will open with various options like Print Money receipt, Print Form etc.
6. After last date of form submission, student’s documents will be verified and the merit list will be prepared.
7. On the notified date, the merit list of selected students will be displayed in the college website and the students will get notification via SMS/students portal regarding the admission process.
8. On the date of admission, the students will have to confirm admission through their login panel.
9. After successful completion of admission process the students will get admission receipt through their login panel.

### College Uniform

The college authority of Pub Bongsor College has prescribed the following garments as uniform for the students :-

**For Boys :** Formal black long pant with pink striped formal shirt.

**For Girls :** White *salwar*, white *churni* with pink striped formal *kurti*.

### Identity Card

### College Library

### Attendance Rules

- b) It is compulsory for all students to have the minimum attendance of 75% of total classes held.
- c) Less than 75% attendance on the part of the student will be counted as non-collegiate. Such student will have to face disciplinary action decided by the College authority.
- d) Students, failed to attend their classes for a week or more on genuine grounds must apply immediately after such absence with supported documents to the Principal for consideration the absence.

### Disciplinary Rules for the students

- a) The students admitted to the College must abide by all rules and regulations as prescribed by the College authority. Violation of rules must lead students to disciplinary actions like termination of scholarship, forced transfer, to make Non-collegiate or Dis-collegiate and even expulsion from the College.

## Background and Structure of GU UG-CBCS

Under the supervision of Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), Government of India (GoI) has already initiated the process for developing New Education Policy (NEP) in our country to bring out reforms in Indian education system. Under the initiation of University Grants Commission (UGC) different universities have introduced Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) in Under Graduate (UG) level to bring equity, efficiency and academic excellence in National Higher Education System. The Under Graduate degree programme of Gauhati University (GU) in newly introduced CBCS at our college will have courses spread across six semesters of BA degree course. The courses in GU UG-CBCS are categorized primarily into three types of courses: Core, Elective, and Ability / Skill Enhancement courses. All the Core and Elective courses will comprise of six (6) credits and the skill courses are of four (4) credits. The CBCS has more advantages than disadvantages.

### BA (Honours)

A student has to choose any one of the following subjects as Honours course. The student has to complete 14 courses (papers) in the whole three years BA degree of the same subject.

1. Assamese
2. English
3. Economics
4. Political Science
5. Education
6. History
7. Philosophy

For BA (Honours) the student has to select one course (paper) on the following courses as Ability Enhancement Compulsory Course (AECC) in Semester I.

1. English Communication or
2. MIL Communication

A BA (Honours) student has to take two courses (papers) as Elective Generic (GE) in Semester I and Semester II (one in each Semester). It is not necessary to choose same discipline (Subject) in both the semesters.

### BA (Regular)
