## *About the College*

Pub Bongsor College at Pacharia was established on the 25th of May, 1994 by the conscious and enthusiastic local social workers of seventeen villages under Pub Bongsor Mouza in the district of Kamrup, Assam. The college is situated on the north bank of the mighty Brahmaputra, and is about sixteen kms away from Gauhati University to which the college has permanent affiliation. The college is a single stream one and provides the courses in humanities and social sciences with seven academic departments affiliated to Gauhati University. The departments are: Assamese, English, Economics, Education, History, Philosophy and Political Science.

After a long period of dedicative journey of teaching and caring-to-each-other of the stake holders, Pub Bongsor College has been provincialized in January 2021. In exercise of the authority conferred under provision 4 (1) of the Assam Education (Provincialization of services of Teachers and re-organization of educational institutes), Act, 2017 & amended Act, 2018 & in pursuance of Govt. sanctioned order no. AHE.490/2020/25, dated 01/02/2020; the services of the employees of Pub Bongsor College, Pacharia, Kamrup have been provincialized and they are now employees of the state government with effect from 01/01/2021. The event is a remarkable in the chronology of the college as the institution witnesses a true and satisfactory culmination of a long history of untiring effort and struggle. The reward at the cost of suffering of its teaching and non-teaching staff for a long period was really meaningful in their individual lives. This was significantly a memorable moment for the stake holders of the college and the people of the locality as well.

The college in a rural background with its semi-urbanized look has successfully been striving for quality education on the course and curriculum framed by Gauhati University since its inception. Presently, the college has implemented the NEP 2020 courses as framed by Gauhati University. With its limited scope the institution of higher education is spreading its wings in different academic and extension activities. The college has numbers of cells and committees to look after the overall administrative and academic activities. Being at the outskirts of Guwahati the campus has a good means of transport and communication. The institution is just three hundred meters away from the Singimari bus stand of State Highway no. 02 and conveniently connected by Pacharia-Singimari PWD Road.

The scenic beauty in the midst of agricultural landscape which is free from noise and air pollution promotes the college for better teaching-learning environment. The state-of-the-art new college building with all modern amenities of administrative and academic setup boost the mind of the teaching & non-teaching staff and students to remain active in the pleasant working environment in the campus. The college being the nearest college to the District Headquarter, Amingaon of Kamrup district of Assam enrolls the students from Sualkuchi-Bongsor (the hub of Assam Silk), Hajo (centre of Brass and Bell metal productions), Dadhi-Bagta-Kismat Bongsor (famous for floriculture), Hajo-Satdala-Bagta (known for fish culture), Singimari-Pacharia-Dalibari-Gondhmou-Bongsor (rich in agriculture) and some other neighbouring places. Enriching its vast and diverse community, the college is in the neighbourhood of IIT, Guwahati; NLUJAA, Amingaon; AIIMS, Guwahati; NIPER, Guwahati; RRLRRS, Gerua; MSME Tool Room and Training Centre, Amingaon; Guwahati Biotech Park, Amingaon; newly constructed National Forensic Sciences University, Guwahati Campus; and newly constructed permanent campus of Srimanta Sankardeva University of Health Sciences. Also there are many local and national level industries in and around Amingaon-Pacharia including EMAMI Limited.

Looking at the potentialities of diverse employment opportunities in the locality, the college is planning for producing skilled personnel and professionals to meet the growing demand of human resources in the industries, institutions and agriculture and allied fields.

### **ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION TO 1<sup>st</sup> SEMESTER OF B.A. (FYUGP)**

For seeking admission to the first semester of B.A a candidate must have passed Higher Secondary Examination or equivalent 10+2 Standard of Council / Board recognized by the State/ Central government authorities.

### **ADMISSION PROCEDURE TO FYUGP**

1. Admission to the College is through online process only in the prescribed Application Form available in the website of Samarth <https://assamadmission.samarth.ac.in/> and in the College Website <https://pubbongsorcollege.ac.in> The candidates have to compulsorily apply in both the websites.
2. Notice prescribing the last date of Admission is hung up in the college notice board and college website usually a few days before or after the declaration of the result of the qualifying examination.
3. The Admission Form must be filled in completely in all respects and the hard copy of the Application must be submitted with the supporting documents. Incomplete Form(s) will be rejected straightway.
4. Admission process is conducted under the direct control of the Admission committee. In case of admission to the 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Semesters, the rules of Gauhati University and the decision of the concerned department will be binding.
5. Admission is strictly on merit and is governed by the admission rules framed by the ADMISSION Committee of the college. The decision of the chairperson of the admission Committee stands final.
6. Any external pressure or interference in the matter (s) of admission will be treated as disqualification.
7. The self-attested copies of the following documents (two Copies each) are to be furnished along with the filled in hardcopy online Application Form:
  - Mark Sheet, Certificate, Admit Card and Registration Card of HSLC&HS and other qualifying examinations.

- Character Certificate.
  - SC/ST/OBC/MOBC Certificate.
  - Permanent Residential Certificate.
  - Gap certificate from appropriate authority in case the student who passed the qualifying examination earlier than the current year.
  - Original Migration/Transfer Certificate for the students seeking admission other than in the 1<sup>st</sup> Semester. “
  - Latest passport size photograph. (4 copies)
8. The original copies of the attested documents must be produced before the Admission Committee.
  9. Presence of the Candidate on the date of interview/admission before the Admission Committee is compulsory.
  10. The fees (if there be any) for admission must be paid on the date of admission after the approval from the Admission Committee.
  11. No request for admission will be entertained after the prescribed date(s) fixed by the authorities concerned.
  12. There is reservation of seats for the student belonging to SC, ST (P), ST (H), OBC (including MOBC) and physically Handicapped (PH) categories as per Government rules. Valid certificate issued by the competent authority must be produced in original before the Admission Committee on the date of admission and the Xerox Copy must be attached with the Application Forms. The reservation of seats is as follows:
    - ❖ SC-7%
    - ❖ STP- 10%
    - ❖ STH- 5%
    - ❖ OBC/MOBC- 15% and
    - ❖ PH- 3%
  13. Admission in other semesters i.e. 2<sup>nd</sup>,3<sup>rd</sup> ,4<sup>th</sup> ,5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> will be completed within 10 (ten) days after completion of the earlier end semester examinations on provisional basis. The provisional admission is to be regularized (for those who fulfil the eligibility conditions of the University) within seven days from the publication of the results of the earlier semester.
  14. Request for the permission for late admission shall not be entertained.

## COLLEGE TRANSFER/PROVISIONAL PASS CERTIFICATE

For a pass certificate/transfer certificate one has to apply in the prescribed format of the college two days ahead along with the following clearance certificates:

1. Fee clearance certificate from the college office.
2. Library clearance certificate.
3. NCC/NSS clearance certificate if there be any.
4. Clearance certificate from student Union Office
5. Surrender of college Identity Card (only in case of transfer certificate).

### Progression and exits

The progression and exits during the whole course structure as per Gauhati University regulation of FYUGP is given below:

#### (a) After 1 Year

One can exit just after one-year. In this case, the student will have to complete one extra Vocational / Skill course (Exit Course) of 4 credits and can exit the programme. The student will get a **Certificate**. The minimum total credit requirements is 44 (and 4 credit extra for the exit Vocational / Skill course).

#### (b) After 2 Years

One can exit the programme after two-year course as well. In this case, the student will have to complete one extra Vocational / Skill course of 4 credits and can exit the programme. The student will get a **Diploma**. The minimum total credit requirements is 84 (and 4 credits extra for the exit Vocational / Skill course).

#### (c) After 3 Years

If a student completes 3 years, s/he can exit the programme. In this case the student will get a **Bachelor's Degree**. The minimum total credit requirements is 120.

#### (d) After 4 Years

After completion of 4 years, the student gets either a **Bachelor's Degree (Honours)** or a **Bachelor's Degree (Honours) with Research**. The minimum total credit requirements is 160.

\* It should be noted that any certificate / diploma / degree is awarded only if the student clears (i.e. passes) all the required courses (papers) till that point of time.

### Multiple exits and entries

The FYUGP allows students to have multiple exits and entries. That is a student can exit the programme, say after one year (as shown above) and then again can enter the programme at a later time and can continue the programme from where s/he left. This process can be executed multiple times.

However, the entry into the programme is subject to availability of positions at that point of time and in that institute / college. Besides, the following should apply

(a) A student will get a certificate / diploma / degree on exit from the GU-FYUGP (depending on in which year the student exits), only when the student passes in all the minimum compulsory courses at that point of time.

(b) After an exit, either after Year 1 or 2, the student can seek an entry only into the same programme to which the student was admitted.

(c) When a student exits the GU-FYUGP after 3 years with a Bachelor's Degree, s/he cannot seek re-entry into the programme at the fourth year, rather s/he will need to take admission into the Master's programme at the first year.

(d) As the contents (syllabi) of all the courses are subject to modification from time to time, when a student enters into the programme after an earlier exit, the contents of all courses will be what is as per the syllabi at the current point of time.

### Anti ragging

The freshers are in safe hands. In order to make the students feel at home and to curb the menace of ragging,

the college has an Anti-Ragging Committee with a visiting squad. Any fresher facing ragging in the campus may raise their complaint both online and offline. For online complaint they may login to the portal of the college website and submit their complaint. The anti-ragging committee investigates immediately the matter seriously and the confidentiality of the complainant(s) is maintained.

### **Grievance Redressal & Internal Complaints Committee**

The college is committed to taking up the grievances of its stakeholders. The Internal Complaints Committee (ICC) addresses complaints and grievances received and responds to these at the earliest. The grievances may be raised both in online (in the portal of the college website) and offline mode.

#### **Student Grievance Redressal Committee (SGRC)**

To formulate a simplified yet effective mechanism for students' grievances redressal, the college has constituted the Student Grievance Redressal Committees (SGRC) as per the guidelines of UGC's (Redressal of Grievances of students) Regulations, 2023. The functions of the Committee are to look into the complaints lodged by any student, and judge its merit. Anyone with a genuine grievance may lodge the complaint to Grievance Redressal Committee.

N.B.:

1. No addition or alteration in uniform will be allowed.
2. All the dresses should be of medium fitting.
3. Any student coming to the college without proper uniform is liable to be debarred from college premises.
4. Hair Style must be nicely cut and well groomed.
5. Specified guidelines for warm clothes during winter season will be prescribed later on.
6. On festive occasions and Special days, the college authority will notify on dress code.

#### **Identity Card**

Each student will be issued College Identity Card within 15 days of admission. During college hours the student will have to possess the College Identity Card. In certain occasions of the college, such as Freshers' Social, Farewel, Student Union Election, College Week etc. the students must produce their Identity Cards if it is so demanded.

#### **Rules & Regulations of Pub Bongsor College**

The management of Pub Bongsor College has set some rules and regulations basing on the guidelines issued by the Government of Assam and Gauhati University. The rules and regulation are binding and all concerned are adhere to the rules & regulations without fail.

##### **A. Attendance Rules**

- The college hour is from 9.15 a.m. to 4:15 p.m. on all working days of the academic calendar.
- It is compulsory for all students to have the minimum attendance of 75% of total classes held.
- Less than 75% attendance on the part of the student will be counted as non-collegiate. Such student will have to face disciplinary action as per the directions of the affiliating university.

- Students, failed continuously to attend their classes for a week or more on genuine grounds must apply immediately after such absence with supported documents to the Principal / Academic Committee for consideration of absence.
- The students must compulsorily appear in the Sessional Examinations conducted by the college and submit the assignments of the concerned subjects and papers within stipulated time.

### **B. Disciplinary Rules**

1. Pub Bongsor College lays great emphasis on discipline and character building of the students. The rules and the regulations of the college are binding to all students of the college.
2. Only such individuals, societies or Association as have been recognised / approved by the Principal, shall have the facilities to the College premises.
3. At the time of admission, the students and the parents / guardians are required to furnished an undertaking in respect of the students' regular attendance in the classes and appearance in the college and university examination as per guidelines / instructions as specified by the concerned authorities.
4. The rules concerning the attendance in the class of the students are strictly maintained in accordance to the instruction of Gauhati University which is notified by the college authority at the beginning of the academic session. The rules for non-collegiate and dis-collegiate of Gauhati University will be strictly adhered to.
5. The rules concerning college examination are strictly accorded to the Examination Committee of the college. And for the university examinations the eligibility conditions and instructions of the university will be strictly followed.
6. The following activities of the students in this college will be treated as serious offences. All powers for disciplinary actions against the offences are vested with the Principal and the concerned Cells & Committee of the College and their decision shall be final in all such matters.
  - i. Encouraging and participating in ragging of any types.
  - ii. Forcible disruption of classes.
  - iii. Destruction of college properties.
  - iv. Making unnecessary hue & cry and blowing of vehicle horn in the College premises.
  - v. Misbehaviour shown towards girls, women, teachers and employees of the college.
  - vi. Uses of drugs, alcohol, narcotics, smoking inside the college campus.
  - vii. Providing any wrong information to the college authority.
  - viii. Damaging and losing of library books of the college.
  - ix. And any other activities that may detriment the academic atmosphere of the college.
7. Students are to keep the photo-identity card of the college with them in the college premises and they may have to produce it on demand. The identity cards shall be made available to the students within 15 days from the date of admission. The identity Cards are to be renewed in each academic year. The old identity cards are to be submitted for renewal at the beginning of the new academic year. Loss of identity card must be reported to the college office immediately and such student must apply for a duplicate one with proper documentation and cost.
8. Students must have a look at the Notice Board soon after they arrive college and before leaving the College. They are also asked to visit the college website regularly for important notifications.
9. College uniform for the students is a must while they are in the college campus (except for NCC/NSS / cultural / sports practices / activities / special days)
10. No vehicle without prior permission from the college authority and without proper documentation will be allowed to enter into the college premises. Students have to obtain prior permission from the college authority for bringing their vehicle into the college premises. Vehicles are to be parked at the parking places meant accordingly.
11. Use of mobile phone by the students within the classrooms, examination halls and in any of the meetings of the college is strictly prohibited.

12. Uploading any controversial post in social media about the college and its stake holders that may prove detrimental to the prestige of the college is strictly prohibited.
13. Any bite to any mass media of communication on the matters related to the college will be made only by the principal or person(s) authorized by the principal.
14. Students' union will be strictly constituted and guided by the constitution of the Pub Bongsor College Students' Union and such instructions that college authority may notify from time to time.
15. Any notices desired to be pasted or circulated by the PBCSU or any individual students anywhere in the college premises shall require the approval of the principal.
16. All powers of maintenance of discipline are vested with the concerned cells / committees. In any critical case the decision of the principal shall be final.

### **Facilities at Pub Bongsor College**

Pub Bongsor College has the following facilities to the students of the college.

#### **A. Scholarship, Schemes, Aid Funds and Awards**

- **Scholarships:** Students are entitled to apply for National Scholarship, State Merit Scholarship, SC/ ST/OBC/ MOBC Scholarships as and when notified by the concerned authorities.
- **Free Admission:** The college implements the free admission scheme of the Government of Assam to the BPL students.
- **Mukhya Mantri Nijut Moina Achoni (MMNMA):** The Nijut Moina Scheme of the Government of Assam for all unmarried female student is implemented by the college since 2024 – 2025 Academic Session. The students are directed to contact the co-ordinator of MMNMA Mrs. Dipa Baruah and Asstt. co-ordinator Dr. Madhumita Das.
- **Mukhya Mantri Nijut Babu Achoni (MMNBA):** The Nijut Babu Scheme of the Government of Assam for unmarried male students of BPL category is implemented in the college since 2025 – 2026 Academic Session. The students are directed to contact the co-ordinator of MMNMA Mrs. Minakshi Das and Asstt. co-ordinator Mrs. Mitu Baishya.
- **Aid Funds:** The college has a fund known as Students' Aid Fund. This has been constituted to provide financial assistance to the poor and meritorious students of the college. On application to the Principal with supporting documents, the Academic Committee will take all aspects into considerations and determines the quantum of aid to the suitable candidate (s) to enable him/her/them to fill up examination forms or purchase of books.
- **Mukhya Mantri Jiban Prerana Scheme (MMJPS) :** Under this scheme the fresh graduates of the college can avail financial assistance of INR 2500 per month for 12 month for preparing for employment opportunities and further studies. The fresh graduates are directed to contact the co-ordinator of MMJPS Dr. Nikul Choudhury and Asstt. co-ordinator Mr. Pranjit Kalita.
- **Awards:** The college plans to implement the following awards to the students of the college from the Academic Session 2026 – 2027.

i. The college will felicitate the students securing the **First Highest Marks (Gold Medal) & the Second Highest Marks** in the Major/Minor subject(s) in the Final Semester examination of Gauhati University. For the first highest marks there will be a felicitation certificate, a packet of gifts and a Bankers Cheque of Rs 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) and for the second highest marks there will be a felicitation certificate, a packet of gifts and a Bankers Cheque of Rs 7,000/- (Rupees seven thousand only).

ii. The college will felicitate the students of all departments securing **First Class or First Division in the Final Semester Examination with CGPA 7.5** which will include a felicitation certificate, a packet of gift and cash money which is will be decided by the Academic Committee.

iii. Late Dinesh Ch. Kalita Memorial Best Graduate Award from Major students. The award contants a felicitation certificate and a packet of gifts.

iv. The departments will felicitate the students securing highest marks in the major course of the department with felicitation certificate and a packet of gifts.

v. The college will provide financial support to the students who takes part in any Inter-University/State/ National/International competition on behalf of Pub Bongsor College. Such financial support will be decided by the

Academic Committee of the college. On winning of any awards in any competition as stated above, the college will organize a grand celebration to honour such students of the college.

vi. Highest attendance award : This award is given by Dr. Pranita Baishya to the student having highest attendance in classes.

### **B. Bharat Ratna Dr. Bhupen Hazarika Library**

The Bharat Ratna Bhupen Hazarika Library (BRBHL) is the central library of Pub Bongsor College. The library is designed and is being developed in the model of GLAM (Gallery Library Archive Museum). The partially automated library is a member of NDLI (National Digital Library of India) Club. Another two auspicious feathers of the library are the Ram Saraswati Digital Library and the Bhumidhar Baishya Human Library. The library has a collection of around 5000 text books, references, journals and other documents covering wide range of subjects. Besides, two regional daily newspapers, seven monthly magazines / periodicals are available in the library. The library has inter-library loan facilities.

A state-of-the-art Library Building with all the internal facilities is under construction and nearing completion. The BRBHL will be shifted to the new building during this academic session.

Moreover, PBCSU & the academic departments will publish wall magazines every year from this academic session.

### **E. Digital Classrooms**

To enhance the digital learning experience for students, the college has equipped its classrooms with a range of advanced e-learning facilities from the academic session 2026 - 2027. These include smart board, microphones, and Wi-Fi connectivity, enabling seamless and interactive learning.

### **F. Computer Lab**

From this academic session the students will have the facility of a computer lab with more than 25 computers with wi-fi connectivity.

### **G. Digital Conference Hall**

The college features a Digital Conference Hall from this academic session that will serve as a versatile space for a wide range of events, including cultural functions, meetings, seminars, and workshops. With its flexible layout and modern amenities, the hall will be ideal for hosting both small-scale and large-scale functions, fostering

creativity, collaboration, and community spirit within the college.

#### **H. Workshops/Seminars/Lecture Programme etc.**

The IQAC, Academic Departments and different Cells, Clubs & Committees of college organizes workshops, seminars, lecture programmes, awareness programmes on different issues like health, road safety, education, culture & traditions, environment, etc regularly in collaboration with different organizations, institutions and associations. All modern facilities for conducting such programmes are available in the college.

#### **I. Students Body of the College**

Pub Bongsor College Students Union (PBCSU) is the students' body of the college. The students' body has its own constitution. All office bearers are directly elected/ selected by the students from among them for a term of one year. PBCSU will have its own office room for the office bearers from this academic session.

Pub Bongsor College will provide two separate Common Rooms for Boys and Girls from this academic session. There will be some recreational facilities for the students in the common rooms. #### **Q. Pad Vending Machine and Incinerator**

From the academic session 2026 - 2027 college campus will be equipped with an incinerator designed to efficiently dispose of waste generated across the premises. This incinerator will help manage waste by reducing its volume, thereby minimizing landfill usage and the environmental impact of discarded materials. By carefully monitoring the types of waste being incinerated and following the appropriate waste segregation practices, the college will ensure that only the proper materials are disposed so that harm is reduced to the surrounding environment.

### **S. Green Campus**

An attractive feature of our college is the greenery in and around the campus. The garden and plantation of trees around the new college building attracts not only the students to remain active in the campus but also the visitors to make the next visit to our campus.

### **T. CCTV Surveillance**

The whole college campus will be under 24×7 CCTV surveillance from this academic session to ensure safety, security, and effective monitoring of activities.
